NTU is committed to the highest standard of research integrity and ethical behaviour in all of the University's research endeavours. A revised NTU policy was adopted in 2012 and it is now a requirement of the University that all faculty, research staff and students undertaking research should sign a Declaration that they will abide by the policy.

To help ensure our research community adhere to the basic principles of ethics when conducting research, the University had launched a compulsory online course - 'the **Epigeum Research Integrity Programme**' via the online NTULearn learning portal. The aim of this course is to enable faculty members, research personnel, and students to be well versed in the key elements of research integrity.

The course module is available in five different tracks accessed via the NTULearn e-portal. Our School has selected the first 2 tracks in the programme as most relevant for our staff:

- **Social and Behavioural Sciences**
- **Arts and Humanities**
- Biomedical Sciences
- Natural and Physical Sciences
- Engineering and Technology
